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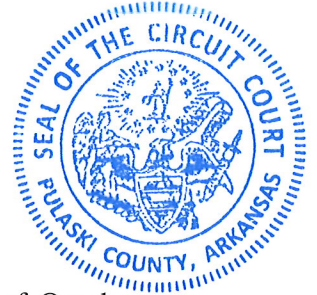

FIRST SUPPLEMENT TO BILL OF ASSURANCE

This First Supplement to Bill of Assurance executed this 22 day of October, 2019, is made by PotlatchDeltic Real Estate, LLC (“PotlatchDeltic,” also “Developer” or “Declarant”) as hereinafter set forth:

WHEREAS, Developer caused to be filed in the office of the Circuit Clerk and Ex-Officio Recorder of Pulaski County, Arkansas, those certain Bills of Assurance to Chenal Valley, an addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, on December 21, 2018 and December 26, 2018, Instrument Nos. 2018078735 and 2018079014 (collectively, the “Bill of Assurance”) creating the Caurel Court Neighborhood; *Plat # 2019067362*

WHEREAS, paragraph 1 of the Bill of Assurance specifically provides that the Developer has the right to bring within the plan and the Bill of Assurance additional properties provided such properties are in accord with the general plan of development and may contain such complementary additions and modifications of the provisions of the Bill of Assurance necessary to reflect the different character, if any, of the added properties; and

WHEREAS, Developer files this First Supplement to Bill of Assurance for the purpose of adding additional property to the Caurel Court Neighborhood, which property is owned by the Developer and is described as follows:

PART OF THE W1/2 OF SECTION 15, AND PART OF THE E1/2 OF SECTION 16, ALL IN T-2-N, R-14-W, LITTLE ROCK, PULASKI COUNTY, ARKANSAS, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: BEGINNING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 29, BLOCK 56, CHENAL VALLEY ADDITION TO THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, PULASKI COUNTY, ARKANSAS; THENCE N75°19'42"W, ALONG A DISTANCE OF 56.49 FEET; THENCE N69°51'42"W, A DISTANCE OF 225.00 FEET; THENCE N72°13'53"W, A DISTANCE OF 41.91 FEET; THENCE N39°03'01"W, A DISTANCE OF 77.49 FEET; THENCE N08°32'07"W, A DISTANCE OF 69.97 FEET; THENCE N01°29'21"E, A DISTANCE OF 415.27 FEET; THENCE N01°28'32"E, A DISTANCE OF 399.20 FEET; THENCE S74°54'52"E, A DISTANCE OF 465.51 FEET; THENCE S69°51'42"E, A DISTANCE OF 512.58 FEET; THENCE S01°30'47"W, A DISTANCE OF 126.32 FEET; THENCE S27°35'35"E, A DISTANCE OF 510.56 FEET TO A

POINT ON THE NORTHERLY RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF CHALAMONT DRIVE; THENCE ALONG SAID NORTHERLY RIGHT OF WAY LINE FOLLOWING THE ARC OF A 507.47 FOOT RADIUS CURVE TO THE LEFT, HAVING A CHORD BEARING AND DISTANCE OF S62°05'16"W, 316.51 FEET; THENCE CONTINUE ALONG SAID NORTHERLY RIGHT OF WAY LINE S41°54'43"W, A DISTANCE OF 187.21 FEET; THENCE N48°05'17"W, A DISTANCE OF 175.00 FEET; THENCE N41°54'43"E, A DISTANCE OF 75.00 FEET; THENCE N48°05'17"W, A DISTANCE OF 45.00 FEET; THENCE N65°02'45"W, A DISTANCE OF 43.78 FEET; THENCE N88°30'39"W, A DISTANCE OF 149.52 FEET; THENCE S25°42'47"W, A DISTANCE OF 50.81 FEET; THENCE ALONG THE ARC OF A 277.50 FOOT RADIUS CURVE TO THE RIGHT, HAVING A CHORD BEARING AND DISTANCE OF S63°35'15"E, 6.78 FEET; THENCE S57°51'54"W, A DISTANCE OF 113.87 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. CONTAINING 20.292 ACRES, MORE OR LESS

shown on the Plat hereinafter mentioned, as Lots 31–57, Block 56, Lots 1-12, Block 57, Lots 1-13, Block 58, Tracts E, F and G, Block 56, Tract H, Block 57, and Tract I, Block 58, Chenal Valley, an Addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas (which property together with the property described in the Bill of Assurance is hereinafter referred to as the “Caurel Court Neighborhood”); and Developer has caused to be incorporated Caurel Court Property Owners Association, Inc., for the purpose of administering the maintenance of the common area tracts, pedestrian path, and amenities in the Caurel Court Neighborhood and Chenal Valley Property Owners Association, Inc. for the purpose of administering the maintenance of the common area tracts and amenities of Chenal Valley;

WHEREAS, all owners of lots within the Caurel Court Neighborhood are members of Caurel Court Property Owners Association, Inc. as provided for in the Bill of Assurance, as amended, and members of Chenal Valley Property Owners Association, Inc. as provided for in the Covenants and Restrictions filed November 22, 1989, in the Office of the Circuit Clerk of Pulaski County, Arkansas, as Instrument No. 89-61706, as amended (the “Covenants and Restrictions”); and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable that all of the property shown on the plat hereinafter mentioned be subdivided into building lots, tracts and streets as shown on the Plat filed herein, and that said property be held, owned and conveyed subject to the protective covenants contained in the Covenants and Restrictions and Bill of Assurance, as amended, in order to enhance the value of the Caurel Court Neighborhood.

NOW, THEREFORE, Developer for and in consideration of the benefits to accrue to it, its successors and assigns, which benefits it acknowledges to be of value has caused to be made a plat showing a survey made by Daniel Havner, Registered Land Surveyor, dated 10/22/19, and bearing a Certificate of Approval executed by the Department of

Comprehensive Planning of the City of Little Rock, and showing the boundaries and dimensions of the property now being subdivided into lots, tracts and streets (the "Plat").

PotlatchDeltic hereby donates and dedicates to the public an easement of right-of-way on, over and under the streets and right-of-way reflected on said Plat to be used as public streets. There are certain easements for drainage, sanitary sewer and utilities as reflected more particularly on the Plat which PotlatchDeltic hereby donates and dedicates to and for the use of public utilities ("Public Utilities") in accordance with further terms and conditions of this First Supplement to Bill of Assurance, the same being, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, electric power, gas, telephone, water, drainage, sanitary sewer and cable television with the right hereby granted to the persons, firms or corporations engaged in the supplying of such utilities to use and occupy such easements, and to have free ingress and egress therefrom for the installation, maintenance, repair and replacement of such utility services.

ALL DRAINAGE EASEMENTS ARE TO REMAIN UNOBSTRUCTED.

The use of the areas designated on the Plat as Tracts E, F and G, Block 56, Tract H, Block 57, and Tract I, Block 58, Chenal Valley, an addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, is further hereby donated and dedicated by PotlatchDeltic to the owners, as they may exist from time to time, of lots within the Caurel Court Neighborhood with the right, subject to further terms and conditions of the Plat and the Bill of Assurance, to use the area for landscaping. The Caurel Court Property Owners Association, Inc. shall maintain such areas and improvements at its sole cost. No improvements by any party shall be placed on the area designated as Tracts E, F and G, Block 56, Tract H, Block 57, and Tract I, Block 58, Chenal Valley, an addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, unless first approved by PotlatchDeltic, the appropriate agencies of the City of Little Rock, Caurel Court Property Owners Association, Inc. and the Architectural Control Committee established pursuant to the Covenants and Restrictions of Chenal Valley.

The use of the area designated on the Plat as Tract F, Block 56, Chenal Valley, an addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, is further hereby donated and dedicated by PotlatchDeltic to the owners, as they may exist from time to time, of lots within the Caurel Court Neighborhood with the right, subject to further terms and conditions of the Plat and this Bill of Assurance, to use the area for a pedestrian path and landscaping, and the Caurel Court Property Owners Association, Inc. shall maintain such area and improvements at its sole cost. No improvements by any party shall be placed on the area designated as Tract F, Block 56, Chenal Valley, an addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, unless first approved by PotlatchDeltic, the appropriate agencies of the City of Little Rock, Caurel Court Property Owners Association, Inc. and the Architectural Control Committee established pursuant to the Covenants and Restrictions of Chenal Valley.

The use of the area designated on the Plat as Tract G, Block 56, Chenal Valley, an addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, is further hereby donated and dedicated by PotlatchDeltic to the owners, as they may exist from time to time, of lots within the Caurel Court

Neighborhood with the right, subject to further terms and conditions of the Plat and this Bill of Assurance, to use the area for landscaping, drainage, drainage overflow and storm water detention, and the Caurel Court Property Owners Association, Inc. shall maintain such above ground areas and improvements at its sole cost. The City of Little Rock shall maintain, repair and replace all underground improvements. No improvements by any party shall be placed on the area designated as Tract G, Block 56, Chenal Valley, an addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, unless first approved by PotlatchDeltic, the appropriate agencies of the City of Little Rock, Caurel Court Property Owners Association, Inc. and the Architectural Control Committee established pursuant to the Covenants and Restrictions of Chenal Valley.

PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF ANY INSTALLATION OF UTILITIES WITHIN THE UTILITY EASEMENTS REFLECTED ON THE PLAT, THE PUBLIC UTILITIES MUST SUBMIT WRITTEN PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL COMMITTEE FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL.

ALL UTILITIES TO BE INSTALLED BY PUBLIC UTILITIES AFTER PLATTING OF THE PUBLIC STREETS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL COMMITTEE PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION AND IF SUBSEQUENTLY INSTALLED IN THE PUBLIC STREETS OR IN ANY EASEMENT ADJACENT TO THE PUBLIC STREETS, SUCH INSTALLATION MUST BE AT A DEPTH OF AT LEAST 30" BELOW THE ELEVATION OF THE ADJACENT STREET.

DEVELOPER, ITS SUCCESSORS OR ASSIGNS, HAS NO DUTY TO MAINTAIN, REPAIR OR REPLACE ANY IMPROVEMENTS LOCATED WITHIN THE TRACTS OR WITHIN OTHER EASEMENT AREAS REFLECTED ON THE PLAT. ALL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH ANY SUCH MAINTENANCE, REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF SUCH IMPROVEMENTS, AND ALL LANDSCAPING TREATMENTS, IS THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ASSOCIATION, TO THE EXTENT SUCH COSTS ARE NOT A RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS OR THE UTILITY PROVIDER.

The filing of this First Supplement to Bill of Assurance and Plat for record in the office of the Circuit Clerk and Ex-Officio Recorder of Pulaski County shall be a valid and complete delivery and dedication of the easements subject to the limitations herein set out.

The lands embraced in the Plat shall be forever known as as Lots 31–57, Block 56, Lots 1-12, Block 57, Lots 1-13, Block 58, Tracts E, F and G, Block 56, Tract H, Block 57, and Tract I, Block 58, Chenal Valley, an Addition to the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, and any and every deed of conveyance of any lot in the Caurel Court Neighborhood, describing the same by the number shown on said plat shall always be deemed a sufficient description thereof.

1. Use of Land. The land herein platted shall be held, owned and used only as residential building sites. No structures shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain on any building site other than a single detached single-family residence.

2. Architectural Control. No improvements shall be constructed or maintained upon any lot or Tract and no alteration or repainting to the exterior of any improvement, including, but not limited to, walls, retaining walls and swimming pools, shall be made and no landscaping performed unless approved by the Architectural Control Committee as provided for in the Covenants and Restrictions and the Bill of Assurance.

3. Common Amenities. The areas designated on the Plat as Tracts E, F and G, Block 56, Tract H, Block 57, and Tract I, Block 58, and all improvements thereon, and landscaped areas shall be maintained by the Caurel Court Property Owners Association, Inc., to the extent they are not the responsibility of the City of Little Rock, except for public utility improvements, which are maintained by such public utilities.

4. Setback Requirements. No residence shall be located on any lot nearer to the front lot line, rear lot line or the side street line than twenty-five (25) feet, UNLESS SHOWN OTHERWISE ON THE PLAT. No building shall be located nearer to an interior lot side line than seven (7) feet. Such setback requirements may be modified if such modification is approved by the Architectural Control Committee, the Little Rock Planning Commission or the Little Rock Board of Adjustment, and such other regulatory agency as may succeed to their functions. For the purposes of this covenant, eaves, steps and porches not under roofs shall not be considered as a part of the building. Where two or more lots are acquired as a single building site, the site building lines shall refer only to those bordering the adjoining property owners.

4. Minimum Square Feet Area. No residence shall be constructed or permitted to remain on any building site in the Caurel Court Neighborhood unless the finished heated living area, exclusive of porches, patios, garages, breezeways, exterior stairways, porte cocheres, storage areas and outbuildings, shall be equal to or exceed that shown in the following schedule:

All Lots	1,800	2,200

Finished heated living area shall be measured in a horizontal plane to the face of the outside wall on each level.

5. Easements for Public Utilities and Drainage. Easements for the installation, maintenance, repair and replacement of utility services, sanitary sewer, drainage and storm drainage overflow have heretofore been donated and dedicated, said easements being of various widths, reference being hereby made to the Plat filed herewith for a more specific description of

type, width and location thereof. Except as otherwise provided herein, no trees, shrubbery, incinerators, structures, buildings, fences or similar improvements shall be grown, built or maintained within the area of such utility, drainage or storm drainage overflow easement. In the event any trees, shrubbery, incinerators, structures, buildings, fences or similar improvements shall be grown, built or maintained within the area of such easement, no person, firm or corporation engaged in supplying public utility services shall be liable for the destruction of same in the installation, maintenance, repair or replacement of any utility service located within the area of such easement.

The Owner of a lot is solely responsible for the existing drainage course across his lot. The Caurel Court Property Owners Association, Inc. is only responsible for maintenance and replacement of drainage equipment and facilities existing within the easements granted herein and described on the Plat that are not the responsibility of the City of Little Rock, and has no responsibility for the maintenance and repair of any drainage course or equipment located upon those areas of the lot outside the easement.

6. Access Easement Agreement. Prior to the recording of this First Supplement to Bill of Assurance, a portion of Tract G, Block 56 and Lots 48 and 49, Block 56 were subject to an Access Easement Agreement recorded as Document No. 2004025127 in the real estate records of Pulaski County, Arkansas.

Documents executed by the Little Rock Water Reclamation Commission and PotlatchDeltic Real Estate, LLC, successor to Deltic Timber Corporation, will be executed and recorded in the real estate records of Pulaski County, Arkansas releasing and excluding Lots 48 and 49, Block 56 from the terms and conditions of the Access Easement Agreement.

7. Incorporation of Terms of Bill of Assurance. Said lands herein platted and any interest therein are hereby added to and made a part of the Caurel Court Neighborhood and shall, on and after the date hereof, be subject to all of those certain terms, covenants and restrictions contained in the Covenants and Restrictions described herein and the Bills of Assurance filed December 21, 2018 and December 26, 2018, as Instrument Nos. 2018078735 and 2018079014, and all supplements and amendments thereto, all of which are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
